 <u>Declaration</u> and hand this over to the Registrar when collecting your pack.

2nd Club Competition Meet—Friday 1st November 2024

Our 2nd Club Competition will be Friday 1/11 with events starting at 5pm. If any parents/caregivers are able to assist with set up this Friday it would be greatly appricated as we have Javelin and high jump mats to set up. If unsure please see one of our committee members wearing the club shirt.

The Point Score system will commence from this date. Every athlete will receive a point for every event they participate in and an additional point for every personal best (PB) they achieve. Results HQ (RHQ)

View and track your child's results from each Friday Meet using your Results HQ (RHQ) Family Portal. Results are generally available on your portal early the following week.

First time users are required to activate their **RHO family portal.**

The Username (is the email used when registering the child via the RevSport portal). Click on the "Having Trouble Logging" and follow the prompts to reset your password. Check your JUNK or SPAM if you have not received the email.

Once logged, view your child/children's results and track their progress. You will find a list of Carnivals under the Nomination tab where you will be able to nominate to attend. Where to place Bib Numbers & patches on uniforms.

The Bib number, age patch and Coles patch are all required to be sewed on pinned on the Club Uniform.

Please note athletes will not be allowed to compete if they do not have their bib number displayed on their uniform. If you are waiting on a uniform order to be filled please pin the bib number on the front of the child's clothing in the interim.

Refer to the photos on the side to view where the patches are placed.

Bib number—Sew or pin in center of singlet or crop top

Age patch - top left hand side of singlet.

If wearing crop top/ lycra shorts set, age patch is to be placed on the bottom front left hand side of shorts.

Coles patch to be place on top right hand side of Uniform.

Zone Championships

Nominations are now open for Zone Championships. Zone will be held on Sunday 24th November 2024 at McAllister Oval, West Wyalong. Zone is open for athletes from 7 years through to 17 years.

Athletes aged 7 years to 11 years are allowed to nominate a maximum of 4 events. Athletes aged 12 years and over are allowed to nominate a maximum of 6 events. Cost is \$6 per event. Reminder to parents/caregivers it's a condition of entry that each family assist with the allocated duties the club will be assigned. Further information will be sent out to families closer to the day. Please note there will be fee of \$10 per athlete that progresses to Regional Championships
